FNSA Pre-Convention Workshop

Why attend Pre-Convention? Pre-Convention prepares students to serve as delegates, informs them about scholarships, fundraising, writing resolutions and all other aspects of the organization, and most importantly the annual convention. Pre- Convention provides a great opportunity to network and learn how to become more involved with FNSA but also with your local SNA chapter.

Each member of the FNSA will talk briefly of their position as well as their committee. There will also be a presentation on awards that schools are able to win at Convention.

Award submissions that are due at Pre- Convention:
Dean/ Director of the Year & Clinical Advocate of the Year

Special Recognition will be given to a Dean/Director who has shown support to his/ her SNA Chapter throughout the year. To nominate this person, the Chapter must submit a TYPED DETAILED letter, 500 words or more, that explains the type of help and support given. Winner will be invited to the Awards Luncheon (October 27 th), where the award will be presented.

The Clinical Advocate award will be presented to a clinical nurse who demonstrates professionalism and is an inspiration to the next generation of nurses. Nominations are made by submitting a TYPED DETAILED letter, 500 words or more, explaining the type of help, support and educational experiences provided by the nominee. Winner will be invited to Convention and recognized at the Awards Luncheon.

Annual FNSA Convention


